

Attendance Requirements for MJHS

Students must be in attendance for 90% of the school year in order to receive credit. **All absences (excused or unexcused)** are counted within the 90% attendance requirement.

Parents/guardians will be contacted throughout the year when a student has accumulated excessive absences.

A parent/student conference with an Administrator will be scheduled at the tenth (10) absence.

A Truancy Diversion Plan may be developed.

A parent/student conference with an Administrator will be scheduled at the fifteenth (15) absence.

A Truancy Diversion Plan will be developed. In addition, a plan (known as the "Principal's Plan") will be discussed and implemented if the student continues to be absent from school.

A student/parent conference with an Administrator will be scheduled at the nineteenth (19+) absence.

The Principal's Plan (which includes attendance and instructional requirements) will be implemented and must be completed (along with passing the STAAR Test requirements) in order for the student to be eligible to receive credit to promote to the next grade level.

A student that continues to be absent more than 20 days will be referred to Truancy Court.
